02. Are the lyrics easy to understand? Explain why or why not.
03. How many stanzas does your song contain?
04. How many lines are in each stanza?
05. Is there a repeated refrain? If so, how many times is it repeated?
06. What is the rhyme scheme of the song lyrics? Write the last word of each line and the appropriate letter to represent the rhyme scheme.

07. Do your song lyrics contain dialogue? If so, who is talking to one another? Explain.
08. From what point of view are the lyrics written? (First, Second, Third?)
Who is supposed to be singing? (a girl in love, a heartbroken guy, someone singing to something, etc)
09. Are there emotions displayed in the song lyrics? Explain why or why not.

*** Layout for Song Lyric Poster Project...

Format to follow:

- Center your song lyrics on the construction paper
 - At the top - place your favorite line in the song (to be used as the title) with the artist's name
 - On the right side – write the rhyme scheme
 - On the left side – write one statement to describe the song's main point, content, or idea
 - At the bottom, on the left side – list the number of stanzas found in your lyrics (whether it's 1 or 20)
